

If your Local By-Laws conflict with the new "Funds" as approved by the Grand Aerie Board of Trustees, you must change your bylaws so you are compliant with the 2016 Rules & Regulations.

Due to these changes, there may be funds that need to be transferred to accommodate these changes. This can be accomplished in two ways. 1) Earmark the necessary amount and leave it in the present fund until depleted OR; 2) Transfer the necessary amount this ONE time and send a copy of the transfer paperwork to the Grand Aerie Financial Advisor showing the transfer. Please keep in mind that there must be at least enough funding in the benefit Fund for the next two (2) Grand and State per-capita tax and Funeral Benefit payments, plus enough for any earmarked funds that remain in the Benefit Fund.
