

Volunteers: To everyone who lends a hand or leads an event, I thank you! I can't say it enough. Without each of you, we wouldn't be as strong as we are.


Remember, just ask. Any officer should be able to point you to who is running an event and help you help us. Always, what you get out of the Aerie is what you put into it.
